BACKGROUND

At the January 26, 2016 planning committee meeting in Juneau, trustees requested a list of Trustfunded grants. The attached documents provide a listing of all FY15 & FY16 grants, both MHTAAR and authority grants, that were awarded June 1, 2014, through February 11, 2016.

The grants staff complied this spreadsheet using the Trust's GIFTS grants database. The spreadsheet is organized in the same order as the grant categories appear in the FY16 approved budget, starting

with non-focus area projects and progressing through each of the focus areas in the following order:

- Non-Focus Area Grants, which also include partnership grants and small projects
- Disability Justice
- Workforce Development
- Housing and Long-Term Services and Supports
- Beneficiary Employment and Engagement
- Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment

Each section of the spreadsheet contains the following column headings:

- <u>GIFTS ID:</u> The internal tracking number staff use to identify projects.
- <u>Project Title:</u> The grant name.
- Grantee: The organization receiving the grant funding.
- Grant Amount: The awarded grant amount.
- <u>Years Funded</u>: The number of years the grant has been funded by the Trust. The Trust only approves projects on an annual basis and does not allocate future funds to grantees.
- <u>Grant Type:</u> A classification system that helps staff track the type of grants issued. These are the same categories used for the annual performance summaries for both MHTAAR and authority grants, which are provided to the planning committee.
 - <u>Direct Service</u>: Projects providing services directly impacting the lives of Trust beneficiaries.
 - <u>Capacity Building:</u> Projects strengthening the skills, competencies and abilities of people and community organizations.
 - <u>Capital Equipment:</u> Projects providing material infrastructure, develop system capacity, and support the improvement in the quality of life for Trust beneficiaries.
 - <u>Capital Construction:</u> Grants for capital construction, major facility renovations or site control.


- <u>Conference/Sponsorship:</u> Conferences, seminars and events that are of direct benefit to beneficiaries or those who serve Trust beneficiaries.
- <u>Data/Planning</u>: Projects supporting data collection, research and planning to aid in the development and strategic design of systems improvements.
- <u>Workforce Development/Training</u>: Projects that support strategies to build and train a capable and competent workforce serving Trust beneficiaries.
- <u>Outreach:</u> Projects providing information and/or services to individuals who might otherwise not have access.
